ADMINISTRATION OF OATH

The Deputy Speaker, (Hon. Jonathan Lemoosa): Hon. Members, I now call upon two Hon. Members to step out and usher in our newly Specially Elected Member, Ms. Stacey Lekirimpoto.

(Hon. Lobura and Hon. Silapia steps out. Hon. Lobura and Hon. Silapia Usher in Ms. Stacey Lekirimpoto to the floor)

Specially Elected MCA, (Hon. Antonella Lobura): Hon. Speaker, in front of you we have newly special elect, Hon. Stacey Nareyio Lekirimpoto on KANU ticket, thank you Hon. Speaker.

(Applause)

The Deputy Speaker, (Hon. Jonathan Lemoosa): Hon. Members, I now administer the oath of office to our special elect, Ms. Stacey Lekirimpoto.
